

Stupid Internet Explorer Tricks

Shortcut to websites

Most websites we visit start with www and end with com. Here is a shortcut. In the address bar of Internet Explorer type only the middle part of the website, then press CTRL + Enter. CTRL + Enter will automatically add the www prefix and the com suffix.

Make more room for your webpage

If you want to see more of a webpage, simply press F11. This will shrink the menu bar and buttons at the top of the page. Press F11 again to restore to normal view.

Recent websites

Press F4 to expand the address bar to display recently entered addresses.

Refresh

Press F5 to refresh the current page.

Forward and back

Press ALT + left arrow to move back on page. Press ALT + right arrow to move forward one page.

Close

Press ALT+F4 to close any window.

Organize Favorites

Press CTRL + B to organize your Favorites.

Cut, Copy, Paste

As always... remember to use the best shortcuts of all; CTRL+X=Cut, CTRL+C=Copy, CTRL+V=Paste.
